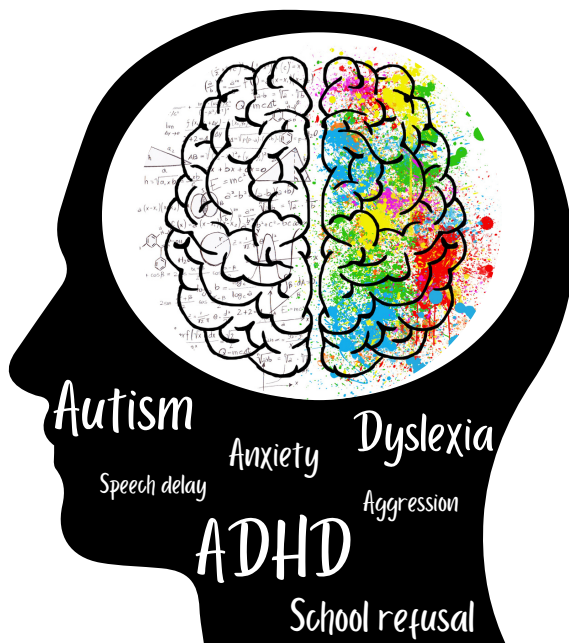

- Measures adaptive behavior from birth to adulthood
- Able to measure adaptive behavior of individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities, Autism spectrum disorders (ASDs), ADHD, post-traumatic brain injury, hearing impairment, dementia/Alzheimer's disease
- Forms aid in diagnosing and classifying intellectual and developmental disabilities and other disorders, such as autism, Asperger Syndrome, and developmental delays
- Age range: birth - 90 years
- Completion Time:
 - Survey Interview and Parent/Caregiver Rating Forms - 20- 60 minutes
 - Expanded Interview Form - 25-90 minutes

THE EFFECT OF THE VIOLENT GAME ON CHILDREN BEHAVIOR



There's been a lot of debate over the issue of how exposure to violent video games and other violent media content, such as in movies and TV shows, affects children.

Studies of children exposed to violent media have shown that they may become numb to violence, imitate the violence, and show more aggressive behavior. Younger children and those with emotional, behavioral or learning problems may be more influenced by violent images.

Besides, many studies indicate that violence in media may be a risk factor for development of aggressiveness in some kids, reduced caring about others, increased confrontational and disruptive behavior, and other antisocial behaviors.

"Kids are changing the way they think" after long-term exposure to violent video games, says Dr. Gentile. He explains that this can lead to changes in both thinking and behavior: "They spend a lot of time looking for enemies and reacting quickly to aggression."



Other than that, spending excessive time playing these games can lead to:

- Less time socializing with friends and family
- Poor social skills
- Time away from family time, school work, and other hobbies
- Lower grades
- Less reading
- Less exercise and becoming overweight
- Decreased sleep and poor quality sleep
- Aggressive thoughts and behaviors



CARA BETUL MENDIDIK KANAK-KANAK BERDISIPLIN

#1 Terangkan pada anak apa itu DISIPLIN

- Beri contoh-contoh yang mudah d faham dan pastikan anak faham dan mula menerima teguran anda.

#2 Bertenang Dulu

- Jika anda berada dalam keadaan marah, ambil beberapa minit untuk menenangkan fikiran sebelum mendisiplinkan anak kerana disiplin tidak akan efektif jika anda seperti melepaskan geram ke atas anak anda.
- Hukum anak atas alasan yang betul dan bukan dengan niat yang negatif.



#3 Beri Kebebasan

- Permainan yang disukai oleh anak, jangan dilarang untuk bermain.
- Beri masa, contoh, bermain dari 5 petang hingga 7 petang sahaja, dan perlu menyiapkan kerja sekolah pada waktu malam.

- Mengingatkan mereka mengapa mereka dihukum tanpa perlu marah-marah juga boleh menyebabkan anak bekerjasama dengan lebih baik.

- Komunikasi dengan anak perlulah secara jelas dan mudah difahami oleh anak.

#4 Berkomunikasi Dengan BAIK Kepada Anak

- Gunakan kaedah 'time-out' untuk mendisiplinkan anak supaya mereka berfikir tentang kesalahan yang mereka telah lakukan.

- Bincangkan semula apakah kesalahan yang mereka telah lakukan dan jangan letakkan kesalahan kepada anak-anak.
